2014 EDUCATION WEEK “Quality Education: a Youth right!”

4-7 November 2014, Brussels

The European Youth Forum, together with its member organisations, will organise the 2014 Education Week in Brussels on 5-7 November. This annual event aims to advocate for the right of young people to quality education in Europe through an interactive exchange of views and practices among all key stakeholders. The programme will address three main topics: 1) policy and practice of quality education for young people; 2) education, skills and employability of young people; and 3) recognition of non-formal education in youth organisations.
